What is Provided in the Gear Truck Service?

Pacific Science Center vans greet Girl Scout participants at the downtown Seattle Amtrak station for select trains and transport their gear to Pacific Science Center. The following morning participants load their gear back on the vans, and collect their belongings at the Amtrak Station from Pacific Science Center staff by 10:30 a.m.

What is NOT provided in the Gear Truck Service?

- Reservations and ticket fees for Amtrak transportation must be arranged and purchased by the individual Girl Scout group.
- Due to security requirements, Amtrak requires passengers to check-in and collect their own belongings (similarly to requirements at an airport). Pacific Science Center Gear Truck staff may not collect your gear from the baggage area nor check-in your gear for your return trip. You must personally transport your gear to and from the Gear Truck which will be located in the Amtrak parking lot.
- Pacific Science Center only transports gear to and from the Amtrak stations. Girl Scouts are responsible for their own transportation. We recommend walking, bus, monorail or taxi.
